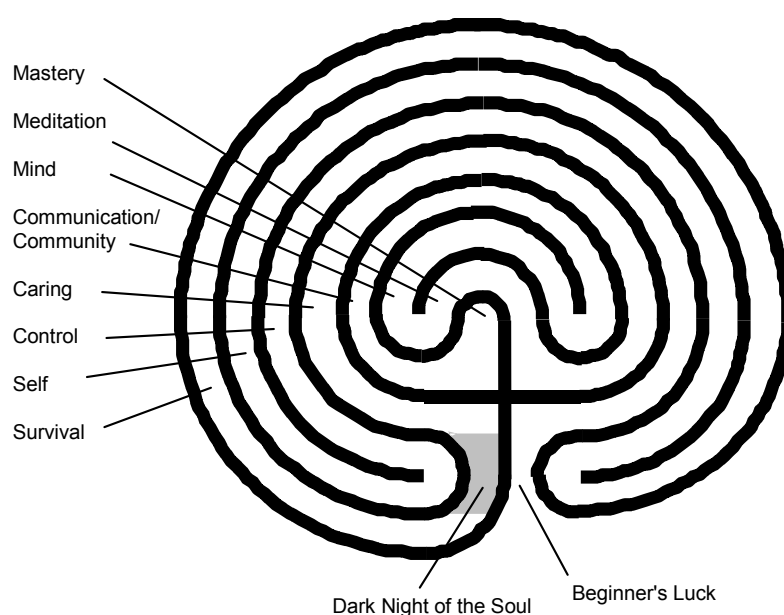

The Skills Labyrinth



The **Skills Labyrinth** is an experiential workshop providing direct, hands-on understanding of the twists and turns of the skills-learning process - for *any* skill, of any type.

Conventionally, progress in learning a skill is often assumed to be linear, a straightforward development from survival-level to mastery. As the labyrinth demonstrates, the reality is a little more twisted - and often a lot more difficult! - traversing through seven distinct stages and two shorter-term transitions. The workshop addresses likely experiences in all of these, and the ways in which people interact with each other on the journey.

Context: may be used at any time, either as a 'stand-alone' or in conjunction with other modules; often incorporated into a broader program of life-skills processes

Outcomes: improved understanding of the skills-learning process; improved ability to learn new skills; improved resilience during difficult phases in learning skills; increased tolerance of others at different stages in learning skills

Format: experiential workshop

Duration: 2 hours

Participants: 6-30; all skills, all levels

Materials: requires minimum 6 metre x 8 metre clear floor-space (indoor or outdoor) for labyrinth; reference-cards provided
